### Minutes of the 34<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Executive Council Date: 22<sup>nd</sup> January, 2018 at 11:00 A.M.

The Vice-Chancellor greeted the members on the occasion of Basant Panchmi and welcomed all the members of the Council. The Vice-Chancellor apprised the Council about the road map envisaged by the University for "Quality Enhancement and Promotion of Excellence" and gave an account on the progress made by the University since its establishment. The Vice-Chancellor briefed that in Academics, the University has 11 Schools of Studies, 30 Departments, Under Graduate Courses in 07 Departments, Post Graduate Courses in 27 Departments, M. Phil in 05 Departments, Ph.D. in 13 Departments with a total strength of 1979 students from 23 States of the Country. It was also shared that the University has total 36 Research Projects, 19 Patents and 1700+ publications to its credit.

The Council considered the case of Dr. Manoj Kumar, an Assistant Professor in the Department of English and Foreign Languages, with regard to his eligibility for appointment to the post of Assistant <i>Professor as per the UGC</i> Regulations on Minimum Qualifications for Appointment of Teachers and Other Academic Staff in Universities and Colleges, 2010. The following facts were brought to the notice of the Council:
	1. The Central University of Haryana issued an advertisement in 2012 for recruitment to the teaching positions.
	2. Dr. Manoj Kumar applied for the post of Assistant Professor in the Department of English and Foreign Languages, under the OBC Category.
	3. As per the advertisement No. 3/2012, qualifications for the teaching positions were as per the UGC Regulations on Minimum Qualifications for Appointment of Teachers and Other Academic Staff in Universities and Colleges, 2010.
	4. The Scrutiny Committee recommended Dr. Manoj Kumar to be eligible for appearing in interview for the post of Assistant Professor in the Department of English & Foreign Languages, with the following notes recorded at the end of its recommendations:
	"The non-NET/SLET/SET candidates and who are claiming Ph.D. degree as eligibility for the post of Assistant Professor, candidates are advised to give full proof document indicating that their Ph.D. degree has been awarded in accordance to the UGC (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D. degree) Regulations 2009, failing which the candidate will be considered ineligible as per the UGC regulations on minimum qualification for appointment of teachers and other academic staff in Universities and college, 2010.
4	The eligibility of the candidates is determined on the basis of the information in the application form and the representation/grievances received after display of preliminary information on website. The same will be finalized after verifying the original documents at the time of interview."
	5. Since Dr. Manoj Kumar had not passed NET or any equivalent examination, he submitted a self-attested copy of the certificate, dated 5.12.2012, issued by Gurukula Kangri Vishwavidyalaya (GKV), certifying that Dr. Manoj Kumar had been awarded the Ph.D. degree in accordance with the UGC (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D. degree) Regulations, 2009, and also gave an undertaking along with his application dated 31.12.2013, before the interview, stating the following :
÷	" I hereby want to state that I have been awarded Ph.D. Degree in English in 2007. In 2012 the University (G.K.U.) issued a certificate regarding UGC Regulation 2009.

I hereby state that I will be responsible for any discrepancy if found at later stage."

Evidently, Dr. Manoj Kumar was declared eligible to be considered for appointment to the post of Assistant Professor in the Department of English and Foreign Languages by exempting the condition of NET on the basis of the certificate submitted by him certifying that he had completed his Ph. D. degree in accordance with the UGC (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D. degree) Regulations, 2009.

- 6. Consequent upon his selection, Dr. Manoj Kumar joined the University as an Assistant Professor in Department of English and Foreign Languages on 13.1.2014 and was confirmed w.e.f. 13.01.2015, after completion of his one year's probation period.
- 7. During the process of verification of the Ph.D. degree in respect of Dr. Manoj Kumar, appointed as an Assistant Professor, on 13.01.2014, in the Department of English and Foreign Languages, the degree-issuing University, viz., Gurukula Kangri Vishwavidyalaya, Haridwar, verified the certificate issued by their Registrar that the Ph.D. degree awarded to Dr. Manoj Kumar in the year 2007 was in accordance with the provisions of UGC(Minimum Standards and Procedures for the award of Ph.D. degree) Regulations, 2009, vide their Certificate No. GKV/Acad./2069/2012-13 dated 05.12.2012. The particulars of the candidate were confirmed by them, vide their letter No. Acad/Res/2016-17/602 dated 25.11.2016, and again confirmed by their letter No. Acad/Res/2017-18/704, dated 17.03.2017.
- 8. The University sought a clarification from the UGC by providing copies of all the communications on whether the Certificate issued by Gurukul Kangri Vishwavidyalaya, Haridwar, certifying that the degree awarded to Dr. Manoj Kumar, in 2007, was as per the UGC (Minimum Standards and Procedures for the award of Ph.D. degree) Regulations, 2009, and whether it could be accepted by the Central University of Haryana for exemption from NET. In response, the UGC has forwarded a communication No. Acad/Res/2017-18/17 dated 17.11.2017, from the Registrar, Gurukula Kangri Vishwavidyalaya, Haridwar addressed to the Under Secretary, UGC for further necessary action, if any. The contents of the letter are given below:

"Reference: Your letter No. F.70-6/2012(CU) dated 30.10.2017.

With reference to your above mentioned letter, it is submitted for your kind information that Gurukula Kangri Vishwavidyalaya, Haridwar has withdrawn the certificate issued to Dr. Manoj Kumar mentioning that he has been awarded Ph.D. Degree as per Regulation 2009 in its Academic Council meeting dated 28/07/2014.

The research scholars who have been awarded their Ph.D. prior to 2009 are being issued certificate as per UGC New Notification where in a candidate has to fulfil Five (05) conditions for exemption of UGC Regulation 2009."

9. The eligibility of Dr. Manoj Kumar for his selection to the post of Assistant Professor in the Department of English & Foreign Languages has been challenged in the High Court of Punjab and Haryana, vide CWP No. 16894 of 2016, in the matter of Sh. Rajesh Kumar vs Central University of Haryana & Ors. This case has been clubbed

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investigate the matter. The Committee may hear Dr. Manoj Kumar and take such evidence as it may consider necessary and submit its report at the earliest for consideration of the Council. Dr. S.N. Singh be paid an honorarium of Rs.10,000/-, per hearing, plus TA as per the University rules; and

(iii) Shri Ram Dutt, Registrar, Central University of Haryana be appointed as the Presenting Officer to present before the Committee the case on behalf of the University.
