We hope to have minimum 10- 15 teams per institution/university in the first round of idea submission for which the last date is 20<sup>th</sup> Jan 2019. The 'Grand Finale' for Software edition is scheduled on 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> March 2019.

The primary objective of SIH is to harness the creative energy and ability to our technology students across all technology institutions (more than 50 lakh students from 6000+ institutions) to think out-of-the-box and offer innovative solutions for the development of our nation. Undoubtedly, SIH has helped India establish world's largest Open Innovation Initiative.

Just like its prequel, Smart India Hackathon 2019 would involve 2 sub-editions:

- Software Edition will be a 36 hour non-stop software product development competition
- Hardware Edition will be a 5 days long hardware product development competition
