The Vice-Chancellor welcomed all the members of the Academic Council and thereafter the agenda item was taken up for consideration.

Resolution No.	Resolution passed
1.	<p>The Academic Council considered and accepted the recommendations of the Committee constituted by the Vice-Chancellor vide Notification No. CUH/2017/Reg./Notification/501 dated August 23, 2017 to examine the issues raised by some B. Tech. students of the University vide their email dated 22.08.2017 vide Annexure-I, and resolved as under:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> That the 49 students who could not fulfill the criteria for promotion to the 3rd semester be given a special chance to reappear in their papers by organising a special supplementary examination after giving them 20 days' prior notice. That till the declaration of the result of the special examination, the students concerned be allowed to attend the classes of the 3rd semester with an undertaking that if they do not fulfill the conditions for promotion as stipulated in Ordinance-XXIX then they will not stake any claim to be promoted to the 2nd year. That the special chance to reappear be given only to those students who had appeared in the End-Semester Examinations of the 1st and 2nd Semesters and were not absent in the End-Semester Examination, in any case. That the students who could not meet the minimum requirement of attendance and had not taken the Internal Assessment test be not permitted to avail the special chance to re-appear. That the special chance to re-appear is being given on the basis of difficulties faced by the 1st batch of the B. Tech. Programme (Session 2016-17) in the peculiar situation and it be not taken as a precedent for the future.

Tech. students of the University vide their E-mail dated 22.08.2017 was held in the Gurgaon Camp Office, Central University of Haryana at 11:00 am and the following members were present:

Dr. Siddharth Shankar Rai could not attend the meeting due to some prior commitments.

The committee examined the representation regarding the major issue of promotion of 49 students and recommended as under:

Regarding promotion of 49 students of B. Tech. of Academic Session 2016-17: As per the provisions of the ordinance a student can be promoted to the Second year if he/she does not have to re-appear in more than 4 papers in semester I and II taken together. However in view of the fact that the admission process for the batch of B.Tech students starting in 2016-17 was finished in the month of September 2016. Thus the session 2016-17 started late. There are 49 students who could not fulfill the criteria of being promoted to the 3rd Semester. Keeping in view the fact that the session started late, the Committee felt that these 49 students be given special chance by organizing a special supplementary chance. It is also recommended that 20 days prior notice be given.

Further till the declaration of the result of the examination under special chance the students may be allowed to sit for the classes of the 3rd semester with an undertaking that if they do not fulfill the conditions for promotion as stipulated in the ordinance then they will not stake any claim to be promoted to the 2nd year.


Here the committee recommends that only those students who have appeared in End-Semester Examinations of 1st and 2nd Semester may be allowed to avail the special chance to re-appear. Absentees of End-Semester Examinations may not be allowed in any case.


The committee also recommends that those students who could not meet the minimum requirements of Attendance and Internal Assessment may not be permitted to avail the special chance to re-appear.


The committee also recommends that the above recommendations for special re-appear chance is given on the basis of difficulties faced by the first batch of B. Tech. programmes (starting Academic Session 2016-17)


due to their session starting late and it may not be taken as a precedent for the future.
