Separate Audit Report of the Comptroller & Auditor General of India on the Accounts of the Central University of Haryana, Mahendergarh for the year ended 31 March 2017

We have audited the Balance Sheet of the Central University of Haryana, Mahendergarh as at 31 March 2017, Income & Expenditure Account and Receipt & Payments Account for the year ended on that date under Section 19(2) of the Comptroller & Auditor General's (Duties, Powers & Conditions of Service) Act,1971 read with Section 31(1) of the Central Universities Act ,2009. These financial statements are the responsibility of the University's management. Our responsibility is to express an opinion on these financial statements based on our audit.

2. This Separate Audit Report contains the comments of the Comptroller & Auditor General of India (CAG) on the accounting treatment only with regard to classification, conformity with the best accounting practices, accounting standards and disclosure norms, etc. Audit observations on financial transactions with regard to compliance with the law ,Rules & Regulations (Propriety and Regularity) and efficiency-cum-performance aspects, etc., if any ,are reported through Inspection Report /CAG's Audit Reports separately.

3. We have conducted our audit in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in India. These standards require that we plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements are free from material misstatement. An audit includes examining , on a test basis, evidences supporting the amounts and disclosure in the financial statements. An audit also includes assessing the accounting principles used and significant estimates made by management , as well as evaluating the overall presentation of financial statements. We believe that our audit provides a reasonable basis for our opinion.

4. Based on our audit, we report that :

i) We have obtained all the information and explanations , which to the best of our knowledge and belief were necessary for the purpose of our audit;

ii) The Balance Sheet and Income & Expenditure Account dealt with by this Report have been drawn up in the format prescribed by the Ministry of Human Resources Development, Government of India vide order No. 29-4/2012-FD dated 17 April 2015.

iii) In our opinion, proper books of accounts and other relevant records have been maintained by Central University of Haryana, Mahendergarh in so far as it appears from our examination of such books.

iv) We further report that :

A. Balance Sheet

A.1 Sources of Funds Current Liabilities & Provisions (Schedule 3) Short term Provisions : Rs. 18.55 lakh

- (a) The provisions for the liabilities payable for the year 2016-17 amounting to Rs. 15.28 lakh has been provided in the accounts. This has resulted in understatement of Provisions (Schedule 3) and overstatement of Current Liabilities (Unutilized grants) by Rs. 15.28 lakh.
- (b) The University has created a "Provision for Accumulated Leave Encashment" of Rs. 13.70 lakh as on 31.03.2017 instead of Rs. 10.09 lakh as worked out by the actuary. Excess provision made has resulted in overstatement of provision for Accumulated Leave Encashment and understatement of Surplus by Rs.3.61 lakh.

A.1 Application of Funds

Loans & Advances (Schedule 8)

Advances on Capital Accounts: Rs. 318.18 crore

- A) The above Includes an amount of Rs. 94.24 crore advances paid to CPWD,NBCC etc. the works in respect of which had already been completed till 31-03-2017 and these had been put to use. These assets have not been capitalized. Non-capitalisation of these assets has resulted in to overstatement of Loans & Advances by Rs. 94.24 crore and understatement of Fixed Assets by Rs. 94.24 crore. This has resulted in understatement of Corpus Fund and overstatement of Current liabilities by Rs. 94.24 crore.
- B) The above also includes advances for building worth Rs.25.55 crore which were near completion stage as on 31-03-2017 but this amount was not booked under Capital Work in Progress head. This has resulted into overstatement of Loans & Advances and understatement of Capital Work in Progress by Rs. 25.55 crore. This has also resulted in understatement of Corpus Fund and overstatement of Current liabilities by Rs.25.55 crore.

B. Grant in aid

Out of available funds of Rs. 472.54 crore including previous unspent balance of Rs.298.80 crore (including Capital Advances of Rs. 224.44 crore)and grant in aid received during the year Rs.80.00 crore, the University could utilize a sum of Rs. 118.96 crore, leaving unspent balance of Rs. 353.59 crore (including Capital Advances of Rs.318.18 crore) at the end of the year.

Out of available additional grants of Rs. 11.29 crore including previous unspent balance of Rs.3.32 crore and grants received during the year Rs. 80.00 crore, the University, utilized a sum of Rs.1.73 crore (Rs. 0.40 crore directly booked in to expenditure and Rs. 1.33 crore booked in schedule 3C of B/S), leaving an unspent balance of Rs. 9.56 crore at the end of the year.

C. General

C.1 Net impact of Audit comments on the Annual Accounts

Net impact of Audit comments on the Annual Accounts of Central University of Haryana, Mahendergarh for the year ending 31 March 2017 is as under:

- i Liabilities overstated by Rs.119.83 crore;
- ii Surplus during the year and Corpus /Capital Fund understated by Rs. 119.79 Crore and Rs. 0.04 crore respectively.
- C.2 As per the Notes and instructions (Schedule 23) for compilation of financial statements of Central Educational Institutions Schedules forming part of accounts, in respect of funds, educational institutions should disclose Assets, such as investments, and liabilities belonging to each fund separately.

The University has been receiving the General Development Assistance grants from University Grants Commission. Besides, the University received additional grants of Rs. 7.97 crore during the year 2016-17.

Thus, It has been noticed that Assets, such as investments, and liabilities belonging to each fund has not been shown separately under each fund as per above requirement of format of Financial Statements applicable to the University.

C.3 Receipt and Payment Account has not been prepared and included in the financial statements.

D. Management letter

Deficiencies which have not been included in the Audit report have been brought to the notice of the University's management through a management letter issued separately for remedial /corrective action.

- v) Subject to our observations in the preceding paragraphs, we report that the Balance Sheet and Income and Expenditure Account dealt with by this report are in agreement with the books accounts.
- vi) In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us, the said financial statements read together with the Accounting Policies and Notes on Accounts, and subject to the significant matters stated above and other matters mentioned in Annexure to this Audit Report give a true and fair view in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in India:
 - a. In so far as it relates to the Balance Sheet, of the state of affairs of Central University of Haryana, Mahendergarh as at 31 March 2017 ; and
 - b. In so far as it relates to Income & Expenditure Account, of the surplus for the year ended on that date.

Annexure to Audit Report

1. Adequacy of Internal Audit System.

Internal Audit system was found to be deficient as :-

- a) University has not prepared its Internal Audit Manual.
- b) Pre-audit system was in existence. One Consultant for Internal Audit has been appointed by the University but he is performing the duties of pre-audit only.

2. Adequacy of Internal Control System

Internal Control was found to be deficient as :

- a) Confirmation of saving bank balances and Investments with the banks has not been taken from concerned banks.
- b) Confirmation of Loans and Advances from respective parties has not been taken.

3. Physical verification of Fixed Assets

Physical verification of Fixed Assets for the year 2014-15, 2015-16 and 2016-17 was not conducted. Only physical verification of non-consumable items purchased during the year 2014-15 was conducted during the year 2015-16 and no deficiency noticed.

4. Physical verification of Inventories

Consumables material is being purchased as per the requirement of the University, therefore, no system of physical verification of Inventory is in existence.

5. Physical verification of Library Books

Library was having 239311 books as on 31st March 2017. No Physical verification was conducted. However, partial physical verification of books purchased during the year 2016-17 was conducted and 227 books valuing Rs. 9.07 lakh were found missing. Final action in respect of missing books is awaited.

6. Regularity in payment of Statutory dues

As per the records, the University is regular in depositing the undisputed statutory dues.
