**B. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR ADMISSION:**

1. As per the provisions of the Admission Rules of the University, the following category of seats are available under supernumerary quota in UG/PG Programmes:
  - i) Children/Widows of the eligible Armed Forces Personnel (5% of total Intake)
  - ii) Foreign Nationals (5% of total Intake)
  - iii) Sports/Extra Curricular Activities (ECA) (5% of total Intake)
  - iv) Two seats for the wards of Kashmiri Migrants and Kashmiri Pandits/ Kashmiri Hindu families (Non-Migrants) living in the Kashmir Valley
  - v) One seat in each programme (governed by UGC only) for the candidates who are bonafide residents of the Jant and Pali villages, Mahendergarh, Haryana.
  - vi) One seat in each programme (governed by UGC only) for the students who have lost their parents due to COVID-19 pandemic.
2. Candidate desirous to take admission under supernumerary seats must participate in online counselling. Candidate must satisfy the following conditions: -

- i) Must have the eligibility for admission to the programme. Please note that it is sole responsibility of the candidate to ensure eligibility at the counselling stage. The admission of a candidate shall be cancelled if the eligibility claimed by him/her is found to be incorrect anytime during or after the admission process.
  - ii) Must have appeared in the CUET-2024 for respective programme of study of Central University of Haryana
  - iii) Must have valid Certificate/documents for the category applying for (See Sr. No.1).
3. Candidate satisfying the above conditions and desirous to take admission, must register online at University Website i.e. [www.cuh.ac.in](http://www.cuh.ac.in).
  4. The Admissions under Supernumerary Seats quota shall be offered on the basis of existing guidelines published in Information Bulletin for the Academic Session 2024-25.
  5. Only Sports merit certificates of past three years listed by AIU should be considered and the certificate should be either graded or verified by the respective Federation/ Association/University.
  6.
