

LEET Admissions Criteria(2025-26)

1. Registration and Application:

- Students will Register on the official LEET website. The Link for the registration is on www.cuh.ac.in
- Fill out the application form with required information (personal, educational, etc.).
- Upload necessary documents like photo, signature, and mark sheets.
- Students will pay the application fee in online mode through Samarth Portal
- **Application fee:** Rs 1000 (except SC/ST)

2. Entrance Exam:

- Students will appear in the entrance exam with objective-type questions based on the knowledge upto 10th/10+2th
- Results are published online with total marks and rank.
- Eligible candidates are called for counselling.
- Counselling involves document verification and seat allotment based on performance and preferences.

3. Eligibility Criteria:

- Passed Diploma (Engineering) examination with at least 45% marks (40% in case of candidates belonging to reserved category) in any branch of Engineering and Technology.
- Passed B.Sc. Degree from a recognized University as defined by UGC, with at least 45% marks (40% in case of candidates belonging to reserved category) and passed 10+2 examination with Mathematics as a subject.

4. FEE: The candidates are required to deposit the same tuition fee and other dues as applicable to the candidates admitted in B. Tech. in the session 2024-25.

IMPORTANT NOTE:

1. Candidates having any pending backlog in the qualifying degree (diploma) shall not be considered for admission.
2. In case of a tie among candidates securing equal marks in the merit list, the same will be broken in accordance with the following criteria:
 - a. Candidate senior in age shall rank higher in order of merit.
 - b. In the case of a tie in percentage of marks in the qualifying examination also, a candidate securing higher percentage of marks in matriculation/secondary or equivalent examination shall rank higher in order of merit.
3. All admissions will be made on provisional basis. If at any stage, any information furnished by the candidate is found to be fabricated or false, his/her admission will be cancelled.
4. Candidates appearing in the final exam of the qualifying degree are also eligible to apply. Such candidates have to furnish the following undertaking at the time of counseling. *"I am applying on my own risk and responsibility as my final result of the Qualifying Exam has not been declared."*

I do hereby declare that I do not have any backlog paper in any of the previous semesters (Years) of study of the qualifying exam and also, I do not expect any backlog in my final exam.

I assure you that I will produce the proof of passing of my Qualifying Examination with the minimum percentage of marks required on or before September 30, 2025, failing which my admission shall stand canceled and I shall not claim any right on any count whatsoever."
