1. The candidate(s) desirous of taking admission against the vacant seats in B.Tech. programs offered by the Central University of Haryana are hereby invited to participate in the Open Counselling (in blended mode). Tentative vacant seats matrix will be uploaded on the website as and when it will be obtained from CSAB i.e. on or after 22 August 2025.

Note: Tentative seats may increase/decrease at the time of counseling. Admission will be based purely on the JEE-Mains score/rank and thereafter CUET score (Mathematics and Physics) in open counselling.

Note: All the candidates participating in the Open Counselling shall have to fill the registration form on the link given above and pay the requisite non-refundable Registration Fee of ₹300. This registration fee is not payable for SC/ST/PWD/Women/Transgender candidates as per institute rules.

- 3. The candidates getting admission on the counselling day have to pay the Institute semester Fee (₹34086 or ₹15186 for SC/ST candidates) via same link (https://cuhadm.samarth.edu.in/) after login within stipulated time as mentioned above. Thereafter, candidate has to report in the respective department immediately during working hours for physical document verification as mentioned on the website.
- 4. **Waiting List candidates** (if get the opportunity of admission) will be emailed for admission within stipulated time period as mentioned above, so please keep on checking your email regularly. These students after getting admission email also have to pay the Institute semester Fee (₹34086 or ₹15186 for SC/ST candidates) via same link after login within stipulated time as mentioned above.
- 5. Students can apply **for hostel allotment** after physical document verification in the respective departments, as per rules of the institutes. Roll No. will be allocated by the respective departments.
- 6. All the terms and conditions will remain the same as CSAB-2025 except for relaxation in the 10+2 percentage for each category. Admission will be based on the JEE-Mains CRL rank and in case of non-availability of JEE-Main CRL rank candidates, CUET (Mathematics and Physics) score will be considered for deciding the merit.

Terms and Conditions for Open Counselling (in Blended Mode)

- 1. Rules related to reservation are as per the norms of the Government of India.
- 2. If the information submitted by any candidate is found to be incorrect, invalid, false or fraudulent, the seat allotted (if any) is liable to be cancelled. Moreover, such candidates will no longer be considered eligible for admission and will also be liable for legal action. Any kind of refund will not be processed in this case.
- 3. The vacant seat matrix displayed to the candidates will be tentative not final.
- 4. Regarding the aggregate marks of 60% (or 55% for OBC, SC, ST and PwD)

Candidate must have secured at least 60% aggregate marks in the Class XII (or equivalent) Board examination. The aggregate marks for OBC, SC, ST, and PwD candidates should be at least 55%. For B.E./B.Tech programs, the marks scored in the following five subjects will be considered for calculating the aggregate marks:

- (i) Physics
- (ii) Anyone of Chemistry, Biology, Biotechnology, Technical Vocation subject
- (iii) Mathematics
- (iv) A language (if the candidate has taken more than one language, then the language with the higher marks will be considered)
- (v) Any subject other than the above four (subject with the highest marks will be considered).

For calculation of the total marks for five subjects, if the marks awarded in a subjects NOT out of 100, then the marks will be scaled (up or down) to 100 so that the total aggregate marks are out of 500.

5. Be available with admission Fee in your account as it is to be filled in online mode, as because if admission is given to your ward then Fee is to be submitted on that day without any delay. No extension/delay for Fee submission will be allowed to the candidate. If a candidate is not able to submit the Fee, admission will get cancelled automatically.
