GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

ADMISSION UNDER SUPERNUMERARY QUOTA SEATS-2026-27

(UG/PG Programmes)

1. As per the provisions of the Admission Rules of the University, the following category of seats are available under supernumerary quota in UG/PG Programmes (UGC governed):

➤ **UNDERGRADUATE (UG) PROGRAMMES:**

- i) Children/Widows of the eligible Armed Forces Personnel (CW)
- ii) Foreign Nationals
- iii) Sports/Extra-Curricular Activities (ECA)
- iv) Two seats for the wards of Kashmiri Migrants and Kashmiri Pandits/ Kashmiri Hindu families (Non-Migrants) living in the Kashmir Valley
- v) One seat in each programme (governed by UGC only) for the candidates who are bonafide residents of the Jant and Pali villages, Mahendergarh, Haryana.
- vi) One seat in each programme (governed by UGC only) for the students who have lost their parents due to COVID-19 pandemic.
- vii) Ward Quota of Employees of Central University of Haryana: One seat in each UG and PG programme.

➤ **POSTGRADUATE (PG) PROGRAMMES:**

- i) Children/Widows of the eligible Armed Forces Personnel
- ii) Foreign Nationals
- iii) Sports
- iv) Two seats for the wards of Kashmiri Migrants and Kashmiri Pandits/ Kashmiri Hindu families (Non-Migrants) living in the Kashmir Valley
- v) One seat in each programme (governed by UGC only) for the candidates who are bonafide residents of the Jant and Pali villages, Mahendergarh, Haryana.
- vi) One seat in each programme (governed by UGC only) for the students who have lost their parents due to COVID-19 pandemic.
- vii) Ward Quota of Employees of Central University of Haryana: One seat in each UG and PG programme

2. Candidate desirous to take admission under supernumerary quota seats must participate in online counselling. Candidate must satisfy the following conditions: -

- i) **Must have the eligibility for admission to the programme.** Please note that it is sole responsibility of the candidate to ensure eligibility at the counselling stage. The admission of a candidate shall be cancelled if the eligibility claimed by him/her is found to be incorrect anytime during or after the admission process.
- ii) **Should have appeared in the CUET-2026 for respective programme of study of Central University of Haryana.**
- iii) **Must have valid Certificate/documents for the category** applying for (See Sr. No.1).

3. Candidate satisfying the above conditions and desirous to take admission under supernumerary quota seats (See Sr. 1), must register online at University Website i.e. <https://www.cuh.ac.in/admission.aspx>, as per the schedule, by paying requisite registration fee as per details below:

Note: Candidates who have already registered for the earlier rounds of counselling and paid the registration fee, need not to pay the registration fee again. However, such candidates need to register afresh for the Supernumerary Quota Admissions.

4. The **Online Registration** for admission under supernumerary quota seats shall start from **13-07-2026 (Monday)**. The Last date for Online Registration is **16-07-2026 (Thursday)**.

Note: The candidates who have earlier registered and participated in the Open Counselling are required to register afresh using a different E-mail ID for the Supernumerary Quota admissions

5. Candidates are advised to complete the registration process as per the schedule notified on the University website.

6. The details of the supernumerary quota seats in UG/PG programmes (wherever applicable), is available on the University Website.

7. The Counselling (In Physical Mode) for admission under supernumerary seats is scheduled for **20-07-2026 (Monday)**. Students seeking admission under the supernumerary quota

seats shall have to report at the designated Counselling Venue, as per the scheduled date and time, with all required documents/certificates.

8. Guidelines for Admissions under Sports Quota are attached as **Annexure-1**.
9. Candidates must ensure that mobile no and e-mail ID provided by him/her are valid and are active during counselling period. The mobile no and the e-mail ID must be his/her own or of the immediate family members /guardians.
10. **Candidates are advised not to register with mobile number and e-mail ID of cyber-cafe owner or some unknown person, which may lead to communication gap.** Similarly, candidates are also advised to pay the fee from his/her own account or the account of immediate family members/guardians, and **it should not be from the account of cyber-cafe owner or unknown person** as the refund of fee, if any, arising out of cancellation or otherwise will be remitted in the same account.
11. The merit list of candidates reported during the Supernumerary Quota admissions counselling shall be prepared as per the preference given below:
 - a. The candidate(s) having valid CUET-2026 score shall be given first priority for admission.
 - b. Candidate(s) who do not have valid CUET-2026 score but meet the minimum eligibility requirement for the programmes concerned, shall be given second priority for admission.
12. The admitted candidates are required to pay the requisite academic fee of the programme within the stipulated time as mentioned in the Activity Schedule. In case the candidate does not pay the academic fee, the seat shall be declared vacant and will be offered to the next eligible candidate(s) in the order of merit.
13. Vacancies resulting from cancellation/withdrawal will be filled from the waiting list.
14. The Departmental Admission Committee (DAC) will check the eligibility of all the provisionally admitted candidates in the programme. The respective Department may contact the candidate/respective Committee for any clarification related to his/her candidature and may also ask for the resubmission of the documents if required.
15. If the candidate is found ineligible during the document verification stage, his/her candidature will be made ineligible to take admission in that programme and the admission will be cancelled.

16. In case of any query/clarification the students may contact the concerned Head of the Department/ Coordinators of the respective category. Contact details are available on the University Website.

Annexure-1

Guidelines for Admissions under Sports Quota for Supernumerary Seats (2026-27)

1. The Admissions under Sports Category for **PG courses**, the minimum eligibility should be participation in All India Inter University, Inter Zonal Games/ National Games/ Merit Certificate for First, Second and Third Position at State Level Games.
2. The Certificates should be supported by at least two stages and verified by the affiliating bodies/federations i.e. District Level participation followed by State Level participation, National Level, Inter College followed by Inter-University or Trials followed by Inter University participation.
3. For the Admissions to **UG courses** the minimum participation level should be National Games (along with the supporting documents; such as the verified list of the players from the affiliating bodies/federations/associations), Junior National Games or Merit Certificates for First, Second and Third Position at State Level Games.
4. The sports which are included in the recent Olympic Games/Asian Games/Commonwealth Games will only be considered for Admissions.
5. The Students seeking admission to UG/PG courses should be eligible for participation in the Inter-University Games for at least the current year from CUH.
6. Only Sports Merit Certificates of last three years would be considered for admission.
7. The Candidate should be eligible for participation in AIU games as per the AIU eligibility criteria.
8. After the minimum eligibility criteria, the **Weightage for Sports Certificate shall be 50% and Weightage for Sports Trials/ Fitness Test shall be 50%.**
9. The following marks are to be awarded for the highest performance in sports for the last three year.
 - a) A person getting any of the first three positions in the Olympic / World Game/ Commonwealth Game/ World Cup Tournaments / Asian Games- **50 marks**

- b) A person representing India in the above said games / Tournaments- **40 marks**
- c) A person representing India in official test matches abroad and within the country- **30 marks**
- d) 1st position in All India Inter-University / Senior National approved games competition conducted by the respective Federations- **20 marks**
- e) 2nd position in the above said competitions- **15 marks**
- f) 3rd position in the above said competitions -10 marks
- g) 1st position in Zonal Inter-University competitions- 9 marks
- h) 2nd position in the above said competitions- 8 marks
- i) 3rd position in the above said competitions- 7 marks
- j) A person representing University in the Inter-University / State in the Senior National/ Junior Nationals Competitions - 6 marks
- k) 1st, 2nd or 3rd Position in State Level Games- **5 marks**

10. The Sports Trials/ Fitness Test of **50% Weightage** of the candidates having minimum eligibility shall be as per the attached annexures.

11. Resolving of ties:

In the case of a tie at any stage in the preparation of the merit list, candidates securing equal marks will be bracketed together. Their inter-se-merit will be determined according to the following criteria:

A candidate getting higher percentage of marks in the Overall merit (excluding weightage) shall rank higher in order of merit.

That if two or more candidates secure equal marks in (i), the candidate senior in age shall rank higher in the order of merit.

Note: The admission committee shall have the discretion to relax the minimum eligibility for admissions to UG/PG programmes when appropriate.
