



In reference to the meeting held on 09.09.2021 of the COVID-19 Task Force alongside other officials of the University chaired by the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, it is hereby informed to all students of School of Engineering & Technology that the university will remain open for attending doubt classes, Practical classes in laboratories, Practical examinations and offline examination from 20th September, 2021 onwards. In this regard, all students of B.Tech (Computer Science & Engineering, Electrical Engineering, Civil Engineering and Printing & Packaging Technology) are allowed to attend the above mentioned classes in offline mode according to the following manner:

- The students of B.Tech 2nd, 3rd and final year carrying Odd Roll numbers (1, 3, 5, 7So on) are allowed to come in the University campus in first phase from 20.09.21-04.10.21.
- All newly admitted students through LEET (2021-22) may also attend the Lab. classes in offline mode.

The students are instructed to assume COVID-19 appropriate behavioral norms with strict adherence of requisite social distancing norms, the guidelines as indicated in the SOPs released by Ministry of Health and Social Welfare and the order issued by GoI/UGC/State Govt. from time to time. Students should also follow all the guidelines instructed by the COVID-19 Task Force.
