Note: An amount of Rs. 1223 lakhs was earmarked for recurring expenditure excluding pensionary contribution and Non-Net scholarship items and Rs. 300.00 Lakhs for equipment and other infrastructure for the year 2017-18 vide UGC letter no. F.No. 28-2/2017 (CU) dated 12.03.18 and letter no. F.1-3/2017(CU) dated Sept. 21, 2017. So far, the budget for the current financial year 2018-19 has not been sanctioned by the UGC. It may take some time for receiving the approval in this regard. In order to carry out the emergent and day to day requirements of the University, approval may be granted for the expenditure up to an amount of Rs. 305.75 lakhs (in proportion to the actual grant received for the FY 2017-18) for expenditure under recurring head and Rs. 300 Lakhs for Equipment and Other Infrastructure in anticipation of sanctioned budget for 2018-19 from the UGC. The proposal may be considered in the light of urgent requirements of UPS, equipments and other infrastructure, particularly for labs/workshops for engineering and science disciplines. In view of the pressing requirements of laboratory instruments and equipments, the Vice Chancellor (Acting) accorded the approval for the procurement of the same on 9th April 2018 and some bills have been received for payment." After due deliberations, the Council resolved to approve the proposal so that day to day non-salary recurring expenses on equipment and other priority infrastructure for Engineering, Sciences and other departments may be met out of unspent balance	Implemented.

In the absence of any order, there is no impediment for the University to proceed with the promotions of Dr. Bir Singh Yadav and Dr. Sanjiv Kumar for the post of 'Professors' under UGC's Career Advancement Scheme 2010. In other words, since there is no order of the Hon'ble High Court which prohibits the University from making such appointments, the question of any Willful disobedience of the Orders, does not arise.	
	2. However, the doctrine of Lis pendens provides that even an alienee pendent lite is bound by the result of the litigation. In the writ petition, the University is Respondent No.1.
