Note: Statute-2 (Vice-Chancellor) of the University, provides the following provisions: 2.(1) The Vice-Chancellor shall be appointed by the Visitor from out of a Panel recommended by a Committee: Provided that if the Visitor does not approve any of the persons included in the panel, he may call for an extended fresh panel. 2.(2) The Committee referred to in clause (1) shall consist of five persons, out of whom three shall be nominated by the Executive Council and two by the Visitor, and one of the nominees of the Visitor shall be the convener of the Committee: Provided that none of the members of the Committee shall be an employee of the University or a College or an Institution maintained by the University or a member of any authority of the University. The term of Prof. (Dr.) Tankeshwar Kumar as Vice-Chancellor of the Central University of Haryana shall come to an end on 28.07.2026. <u>Resolution Passed:</u> This Item has been taken up in a Special meeting, 70th (Emergent) meeting on 13-06-2026. Three names, as finalized by the Council, have already been forwarded to the Ministry of Education (MoE).

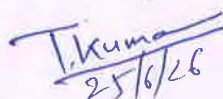

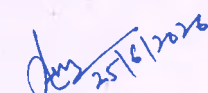

71.11	To consider the Annual Accounts of the University for the Financial Year 2025-2026. (Annexure-S6, Page-32 to 71) Annual Accounts were discussed in detail in the light of the IFD comments on agenda vide letter No. 9-8/2017-IFD-(pt.) dated 15.06.2026 (pages 63 & 64). Expenditure of Schedule-15 has been increased because of making provisions on Gratuity and Leave Encashment as per payment of Gratuity Act 1972 as clarified vide O.M. No. R-13011/02/2022-SS.II dated 23.11.2022 and MoL&E has also clarified that Payment of Gratuity Act is applicable to all employees. As per CAG observation on Annual Accounts for the Financial Year 2024-25, provision of Gratuity and Leave Encashment should be applicable for all employees of Educational Institutions. Hence, provision for Gratuity and Leave Encashment is made amounting to Rs. 31,81,59,378.00. This has also been mentioned under Notes to Accounts at para 6 on page 34. Also, there has been increase in the expenditure on repair and maintenance as AMC for lifts was given in Financial Year 2025-26. <u>Resolution of Finance Committee:</u> Considered and recommended that the same be placed in forthcoming Executive Council Meeting. <u>Resolution Passed by EC:</u> Approved.

The Central University of Haryana was established under Act No. 25 (2009) of Parliament. At Present the University is running 39 Post Graduate Programs, 32 Research Programs, 04 Integrated Programs, 08 Undergraduate programs and 02 Diplomas including Programs of B. Tech and M. Tech. The University is having around 5000 students on its roll.

The University has 142 sanctioned Non Teaching posts and has already filled 114 posts i.e. 80% posts have been filled and the recruitment of Non Teaching vacant post is still in process.

The University has 266 sanctioned Teaching posts and as per the ratio of posts of Teaching to Non Teaching prescribed by UGC, the University should have 292 sanctioned Non Teaching, thereby, a shortage of 150 Non Teaching posts.

The University is facing acute shortage of Non Teaching posts due to increasing work-load in the University. The University administration is facing difficulties in its day to day functioning. The promotion of many Non-Teaching employees is also pending due to non-availability of posts.

In view of the above, it is requested that 150 additional posts as per sheet attached may please be sanctioned in order to bring efficiency and good governance in the University.

Subject: Proposal of Central University of Haryana for creation of 150 Non-Teaching Positions-reg.

महोदय,

This is with reference to the proposal of Central University of Haryana forwarded by MoE vide its letter No. 7-1/2024-CU.III dated 13.12.2024 on the subject mentioned above.

I am directed to convey that the proposal of the University has been examined by a Standing Expert Committee, constituted by UGC. The applicant University also made online presentation before the Committee on 10th March, 2025. The justification submitted by the University and Observation/ recommendations of the Committee are as under:

Justification submitted by the University: The University has informed that around 5000 students are enrolled in 86 academic programmes being offered by 35 Departments of the University. The campus of the University is spread over a vast area of approximately 488 acres of land. Apart from 35 Departments, University has 07 hostels accommodating around 2399 students and 150 families of employees residing in the staff quarters. The University was sanctioned 142 non-teaching posts, out of which 116 posts (81.69%) have been filled as on 06.03.2025. The University was sanctioned 266 Teaching posts. As per the Ratio of posts of teaching to non-teaching prescribed by the UGC, the university should have 292 non-teaching posts. Accordingly, the university requested for sanction of 150 non-teaching posts for smooth functioning of the University.

Observations and recommendations of the Committee: The Committee considered the proposal of the university and observed that currently, the University has 142 non-teaching sanctioned positions and 175 posts on outsource basis. Out of 142 sanctioned non-teaching positions, 116 non-teaching positions have been filled up. As the University is growing in terms of students' strength, number of departments and other infrastructural facilities, a greater number of regular staff will be helpful in the smooth functioning of the University. Considering the vacancy positions under various cadres and the needs of the University, the Committee recommends the following additional non-teaching positions:

The Committee further observed that if the recommended posts are approved by the Government of India, the University should reduce the number of staff on outsourced basis proportionately.

The above approval is subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:

- The University should ensure that departments/ centres should be approved by the Statutory authorities/bodies.
- The University should fill up the vacant teaching and non-teaching positions at the earliest.
- The University should fill up the sanctioned teaching and non-teaching positions in a phased manner on the basis of the actual requirements of the University.
- The University should strictly adhere to the reservation policy for SC/ST/OBC/EWS/PwBD as per Govt. of India policy while filling up the vacant positions.
- The UGC Regulations 2018 related to Minimum qualifications for appointment of teachers and other Academic Staff in Universities and Colleges and measures for the maintenance of standards in Higher Education and amended from time to time should be strictly followed by all Central Universities.

This issues with the approval of the Competent Authority.

Schedule - 23(Significant Accounting Policies)

1 Basis of Preparation

The accounts are prepared under the Historical Cost Convention unless otherwise stated and generally on the Accrual method of accounting.

2 Revenue Recognition

- 2 Fees from Students (except Tuition Fees), Sale of Admission Forms, Royalty and Interest on Savings Bank account are accounted on cash basis. Tuition Fees collected separately for each semester is accounted on accrual basis.
- 2 Income from Land, Buildings and Other Property and Interest on Investments are accounted on accrual basis.
- 2 Interest on interest bearing advances to staff for House Building, Purchase of Vehicles and Computers is accounted on accrual basis every year, though the actual recovery of interest starts after the full repayment of the Principal.

3 Fixed Assets & Depreciation

- 3 Fixed assets are stated at cost of acquisition including inward freight, duties and taxes and incidental and direct expenses related to acquisition, installation and commissioning.
- 3 Gifted and Donated assets are valued at the declared value where available; if not available, the value is estimated based on the present market value adjusted with reference to the physical condition of the asset. They are set-up by credit to Capital Fund and merged with the Fixed Assets of the Institution. Depreciation is charged at the rates applicable to the respective assets.
- 3 Books received as gifts, are valued at selling prices printed on the books. Where they are not printed, the value is based on assessment
- 3 Fixed assets are valued at cost less accumulated depreciation. Depreciation on fixed assets is provided on Straight line method, at the following rates :-

4 Assets created out of Earmarked Funds and funds of Sponsored Projects, where the ownership of such assets vests in the Institution, are setup by credit to Capital Fund and merged with the Fixed Assets of the Institution. Depreciation is charged at the rates applicable to the respective assets. Assets created out of Sponsored Project funds, where the ownership is retained by the sponsors but held and used by the Institution are separately disclosed in the Notes on Accounts.

4 Assets, the individual value of each of which is Rs. 2000 or less (except Library Books) are treated as Small Value Assets, 100% depreciation is provided in respect of such assets at the time of their acquisition. However physical accounting and control are continued by the holders of such assets.

4 **Intangible Assets**

4 Electronic Journals (E-Journals) are separated from Library Books in view of the limited benefit that could be derived from the on-line access provided. E-journals are not in a tangible form, but temporarily capitalized and in view of the magnitude of expenditure and the benefit derived in terms of perpetual knowledge acquired by the Academic and Research Staff;

Depreciation is provided in respect of E-journals at a higher rate of 40% as against depreciation of 10% provided in respect of Library Books.

4 Expenditure on acquisition of software has been separated from computers and peripherals, as apart from being intangible assets, the rate of obsolescence in respect of these is very high. Depreciation is provided in respect of software at a higher rate of 40% as against depreciation of 20% provided in respect of Computers & Peripherals.

5 **Stock**

Expenditure on purchase of chemicals, glassware, publications and other stores is accounted as revenue expenditure, except that the value of closing stocks held on 31st March is set up as inventories by reducing the corresponding Revenue Expenditure on the basis of information obtained from Departments. They are valued at cost.

6 **Retirement Benefits**

Retirement benefits i.e., Pension are provided on the basis of actuarial valuation.

Capitalized Value of pension and gratuity received from previous employers of the Institution's employees, who have been absorbed in the Institution, is credited to the respective Provision Accounts. Pension contribution received in respect of employees on deputation is also credited to the Provision for Pension Account. The Actual payments of Pension and Leave encashment are debited in the Accounts to the respective provisions. Other retirement benefits viz. Deposit Linked Insurance, Contribution to New Pension Scheme, Medical reimbursement to retired employees and Travel to Home Town on retirement are accounted on accrual basis (actual payments plus outstanding bills at the end of the year).

7 **Investments**

7 Long term investments are carried at their cost or face value whichever is lower. However any permanent diminution in their value as on the date of the Balance Sheet is provided for.

7 Short Term investments are carried at their cost or market value (if quoted) whichever is lower.

8 Earmarked & Endowment Funds

The following long terms funds are earmarked for specific purposes. Each of the funds has a separate bank account. Those with large balances also have investments in Government Securities, Debentures and Bonds and Term Deposits with Banks.

The income from investments & advances (House Building Conveyance and computer) on accrued basis and interest on savings Bank Accounts are credited to the respective Funds. The expenditure and advances (in the case of House Building & Conveyance/Computer) are debited to the fund. The assets created out of Earmarked Funds where the ownership Vests in the Institution, are merged with the assets of the Institution by crediting an equal amount to the Capital Fund. The balance in the respective funds is carried forward and is represented on the assets side by the balance at Bank, Investments and accrued interest.

8 CORPUS FUND was established in (year). Matching contribution from University; Grants Commission, Recognition & Affiliation fee received from Colleges and other academic institutions, Institution's share of Consultancy fees and contributions from Research Projects are treated as additions to Corpus fund. Income from investments of the fund is added to the Fund. The Corpus Fund is utilized for both Revenue and Capital expenditure based on the guidelines by the University Grants Commission and the Executive council of the Institution from time to time. The assets created out of the Corpus Fund are merged with the assets of the Institution by crediting an equal amount to the Capital Fund. The balance in the Corpus Fund which is carried forward is represented by the balance in a separate Bank account, investment in RBI Bonds and Fixed Deposits with the Bank and Accrued interest on investments.

8 A.D Fund This fund was established on 1st February 2006. The fund is to be utilized for some of the innovative Programmes, and for sustenance of its research and such other development activities as laid down by the Executive Council from time to time.

8 House Building Advances Fund A revolving fund for the purpose of paying interest bearing advances to the officer' & staff for House Building.

8 JRF/SRF Fund Fund provided by the UGC/Government for the purpose of paying Fellowships to Junior/ Senior Research Fellows.

9 Conveyance Fund (including Computer advances)

A revolving fund for the purpose of paying interest bearing advances to officers & staff for the purchase of motor cars, two wheelers and computers.

9 Rajiv Gandhi National Fellowship Fund

Fund provided by University Grants Commission for fellowship to SC/ST Students of the University.

9 Endowment Funds

Endowments are funds received from various individual donors, Trusts and other organizations, for establishing Chairs and for Medals & Prizes, as specified by the Donors. While each of the Endowment funds has its own investment there is one savings Bank Account for all the Endowment funds, as the uninvested balances against them are negligible.

The income from investment of each Endowment Fund is added to the Fund. The interest on Savings Bank accounts is allocated to all the Endowment funds in the ratio of the year end closing balances in each fund. The expenditure on Medals & Prizes is met from the interest earned on investment of the respective Endowment Funds and the balance is carried forward. In respect of Chairs, however, the corpus of the Endowment is also used.

The balance is represented by Investment in RBI Bonds and Fixed Deposits and balance in the Saving Bank Account consisting of all Endowments, and Accrued Interest on Investments.

9 Government & UGC Grants

- 9 Government Grants and UGC grants are accounted on realization basis. However, where a sanction for release of grant pertaining to the financial year is received before 31 " March and the grant is actually received in the next financial year, the grant is accounted on accrual basis and an equal amount is shown as recoverable from the Grantor. In the opinion of the Management, the current assets, Loans, Advances and Deposits have a value on realization in the ordinary course, equal at least to the aggregate amount shown in the Balance Sheet.
- 9 To the extent utilized towards capital expenditure, (on accrual basis) government grants and grants from UGC are transferred to the Capital Fund for the current year.
- 9 Government and UGC grants for meeting Revenue Expenditure (on accrual basis) are treated, to the extent utilized, as income of the year in which they are realized.
- 9 Unutilized grants (including advances paid out of such grants) are carried forward and exhibited as a liability in the Balance Sheet.

10 Investment of Earmarked Funds & interest income accrued on such investments

To the extent not immediately required for expenditure, the amounts available against such funds are invested in approved Securities & Bonds or deposited for fixed term with Banks, leaving the balance in Savings Bank Accounts. Interest received, interest accrued and due and interest accrued but not due on such investments are added to the respective funds and not treated as income of the Institution.

11 Sponsored Projects

- 11 In respect of ongoing Sponsored Projects, the amounts received from sponsors are credited to the head "Current Liabilities and Provisions -Current Liabilities -Other Liabilities -Receipts against ongoing sponsored projects." As and when expenditure is incurred /advances are paid against such projects, or the concerned project account is debited with allocated overhead charges, the liability account is debited.
- 11 In addition to the Earmarked Fund for the Junior Research Fellowships funded by the University Grants Commission, Fellowships and Scholarships are also sponsored by various organizations. These are accounted in the same way as Sponsored Projects except that the expenditure generally is only on disbursement of Fellowships and Scholarships, which may include allowances for contingent expenditure by the Fellows and scholars.
- 11 The Institution itself also awards Fellowships and Scholarships, which are accounted as Academic expenses.

12 Income Tax

The income of the Institution is exempt from Income Tax under Section 10(23c) of the Income Tax Act. No provision for tax is therefore made in the accounts.

13 Provisions, Contingent Liabilities

The Univeristy estimates the provisions that have present obligations as a result of past events and it is probable that outflow of resources will be required to settle the obligations. These provisions are reviewed at the end of each reporting date and are adjusted to reflect the current best estimates. The University uses significant judgement to disclose contingent liabilities. Contingent liabilities are disclosed when there is a possible obligation arising from past events, the existence of which will be confirmed only by the occurrence or non-occurrence of one or more uncertain future events not wholly within the control of the institution or a present obligation that arises from past events where it is either not probable that an outflow of resources will be required to settle the obligation or a reliable estimate of the amount cannot be made. Contingent assets are neither recognised nor disclosed in the financial statements.

14 Hefa Accounting Policy

Hefa loan is tretated as liability and grant received for repayment of principal is deducted from loan and included in corpus fund.

3 Fixed Assets

- 3.1 Additions in the year to Fixed Assets in Schedule 4 include Assets purchased/installed in the current year have been set up by credit to Corpus Fund. Tangible Assets are stated at cost (net of Input Tax Credit or CENVAT (till 30th June, 2017 the period prior to GST implementation date) wherever applicable) less accumulated depreciation and impairment losses, if any. Cost is inclusive of freight, duties, levies and any directly attributable cost of bringing the assets to their working condition for the intended use. Borrowing costs relating to acquisition of fixed assets, if material, are also included in cost to the extent they relate to the period till such assets are ready to be put to use.
- 3.2 Fixed assets as set out in Schedule 4 do not include assets purchased out of funds of sponsored projects, held and used by the Institution, as project contracts include stipulations that all such assets purchased out of projects funds will remain the property of the sponsors.
- 3.3 Reclassification of Fixed Assets has been done wherever deemed necessary.

4 Corpus

The amount of Grants from UGC, Government of India and State Government to the Extent utilized for capital expenditure is added to the Corpus Fund.

5 Provisions

- 5.1 As per the notification no. 19-1/2017-IFD dated 12.04.2017 Ministry of Human Resource Development directed that the matter of extension of Gratuity and Death Gratuity to the employees of autonomous organisations covered under NPS under the MHRD is under consideration in MHRD in consultation with Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance, therefore the benefits of Retirement Gratuity and Death Gratuity to the employees of autonomous organisations covered under NPS has been withdrawn till a final decision is taken in the matter with the approval of Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance. In the view of the same provision for Gratuity has not been made in the current year.
- 5.2 Leave Encashment : The Univeristy estimates the provisions that have present obligations as a result of past events and it is probable that outflow of resources will be required to settle the obligations. These provisions are reviewed at the end of each reporting date and are adjusted to reflect the current best estimates.
- 5.3 Gratuity: The Univeristy estimates the provisions that have present obligations as a result of past events and it is probable that outflow of resources will be required to settle the obligations. These provisions are reviewed at the end of each reporting date and are adjusted to reflect the current best estimates.

6 Deposit Liabilities

- 11.1 The financial statements of the University (viz., Balance Sheet and Income and Expenditure Account) have been prepared on the basis of Significant Accounting Policies (See Schedule 23).
- 11.2 Normally, Central Educational Institutions cannot raise loans, particularly by pledging their Assets, hence the heads Secured Loans & unsecured Loans do not therefore find a place in the Balance Sheet.
- 11.3 The accounting treatment and presentation in the Balance Sheet and the Income and Expenditure Account, of transactions and events is governed by their substance and not merely by the legal form.

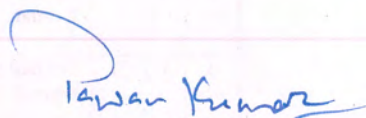
