Different departments of studies contribute equally to the development of humans and their world. Every branch shares a story with a large number of people and comes under journalism and mass communication. The discipline of Journalism and mass communication teaches us to create, manage and monitor the content that goes out to the masses. Mass Communication and Journalism are the two sides of the same coin yet different. If the content is news, that mass communication function is called journalism.
