

ORDINANCE RELATING TO EMOLUMENTS AND OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SERVICE OF PRO VICE –CHANCELLOR (Ref. Statute 4(3) of the Statues)

1. Emoluments

The post of Pro Vice-Chancellor shall be in the Pay Band of Rs.37400-67000 with AGP of Rs. 10,000/- or higher AGP of Rs. 12,000/-, whichever is applicable, along with a Special allowance of Rs. 4000 per month, subject to a condition that the sum total of pay in the Pay Band, the Academic Grade Pay and the Special Allowance shall not exceed Rs.80000. In addition, the Pro Vice-Chancellor shall be entitled to such allowances as may be admissible to other University employees from time to time.

2. Leave

2.1 The Pro Vice-Chancellor shall be entitled to all kinds of leave applicable to whole time permanent teachers of the University, subject to following:

If he/she is a professor of the University discharging the additional duties of the Pro-Vice-Chancellor, or is a person not in the service of the University, but appointed to the post, he/she shall be entitled to leave:

- (a) On full pay for one eleventh of the period spent by him/her on active service as Pro Vice-Chancellor:
- (b) On medical grounds or otherwise than on medical grounds without pay for a period not exceeding three months during the term of his/her office, provided that such leave may be converted into leave on full pay to the extent to which he/she will be entitled to under sub-clause (a).

2.2 Where a person already in the service of the University is appointed as a Pro Vice-Chancellor, he/she shall be entitled to carry forward the leave at his/her credit on the date of such appointment:

3. Provident Fund

If a Teacher already in service of the University prior 01.01.2004 is appointed as Pro Vice-Chancellor, he/she will be entitled to continue to subscribe to the Provident Fund at the same rate at which he/she would have continued to subscribe but for his/her appointment as Pro Vice-Chancellor. However, if a Teacher appointed in the University on or after 01.01.2004 is appointed as Pro Vice-Chancellor, he/she will be entitled to only the New Pension Scheme effective from 01.01.2004.
