**AMENDMENT IN STATUTE RELATING TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF SCHOOLS OF STUDIES
(Ref. Statute 15(1) of the Statutes)**

The University shall have the following Schools of Studies:

- (i) **School of Earth, Environment and Space Studies**
(Geography, Geology, Geophysics, Geotechnical Engineering, Environmental Studies, Remote Sensing and GIS)
- (ii) **School of Life Sciences**
(Microbiology, Biotechnology, Genetics, Botany, Zoology, Anthropology)
- (iii) **School of Physical and Mathematical Sciences**
(Electronics, Physics, Astrophysics, Mathematics, Operational Research, Statistics)
- (iv) **School of Computer Science and Informatics**
(Computer Sciences, Communication, Library, Informatics and Media)
- (v) **School of Engineering and Technology**
- (vi) **School of Medical Sciences**
- (vii) **School of Agriculture and Allied (Agro based technological) Sciences**
(Agricultural Sciences, Food and Processing, Agro-industrial Technology)
- (viii) **School of Chemical Sciences**
(Chemistry, Nano Technology)
- (ix) **School of Arts, Humanities and Social Sciences**
(Political Science, History, Economics, Philosophy, Sociology, Psychology)
- (x) **School of Language, Linguistics, Culture and Heritage**
- (xi) **School of Life-long Learning**
- (xii) **School of Law, Governance, Public Policy and Management**
- (xiii) **School of Journalism, Mass Communication and Media**
