Site preparation: The bidder shall be fully responsible for complete site preparation as per equipment specifications, including any civil, electrical, or Environmental requirements before delivery. The University shall provide only the required space as per the size requirement furnished with simple tile flooring and provision of Air conditioning in the Building. A three-phase electricity point along with Earthing arrangements shall be provided in that space. The rest of the wiring, MCB installations, base isolation etc. as per the equipment requirement shall be responsibility of the vendor for successful installation And testing & commissioning.	1. As the equipment required will be having Single Phase inputs . We request you to provide single phase sockets & switches . Multi sockets with Power (16A) & 6A current will be preferred. As these are table top units , Tables will be required for the setup along with nearby or on table provision of switch sockets.	Agreed
		2) The equipment shall be supplied with a UPS (5 KVA) along with batteries for a backup time of one hour.	2) As UPS is generally required for power backup . One hour backup time will be too high & requires external batteries. We suggest the backup time should be reduced to 15-20 min for power backup with Internal Maintenance free battery.	Agreed

3) The complete system must function as an integrated platform, with centralized control and data Acquisition enabled via the SPA. A unified or seamlessly Integrated software interface must be provided.	3) Integration will be provided between the products compatible & required.	Agreed

Performance Security On receipt of notification of award from the University, the successful Bidder within 14 days shall furnish the performance security at 5% of the cost of the material ordered in the form of DD/FDR in favor of The Central University of Haryana or in the form of Bank Guarantee issued/confirmed from any of Scheduled/Nationalized Bank in India in an acceptable form. Performance security should remain valid for a period of 90 days beyond the date of completion of all contractual obligation of the supplier, including warranty Obligations.	5) As you have asked for performance Bank Guarantee within 14 days of award of contract & delivery will be after 4 months of award . We request you to accept the bank guarantee with Supply of Equipment or at the time of installation for period of 90 days beyond date of contractual obligations of supplier.	Not Agreed
6) Chapter 1: Instructions to bidders Point No 14 Terms of payments for Goods: The payments shall be released on case by case basis whichever applicable, in the following manner: 80% of the total payment shall be released on delivery, satisfactory installation, testing & commissioning of the equipment at the consignee's premises and after "ensuring verification of the Performance Bank	6) As you have asked for Bank Guarantee for period of warranty period + 90 Days against the satisfactory performance of Equipment for warranty period . We request you to amend the payment terms as 90% of the total payment to be released on delivery, satisfactory installation, testing & commissioning of the equipment at the consignee's premises and	Not Agreed

The balance 10 % of the payment shall be released upon successful Test run of the equipment for one month and after ensuring that already furnished Performance Bank Guarantee is valid for a period of 90 days beyond the date of completion of all contractual obligations of the bidder/ supplier including comprehensive warranty obligations.

The remaining 10% of the amount shall be released in the three equal instalments at the end of each year (counted from the date of successful testing & commissioning of the equipment).

7) Chapter 1: Instructions to bidders Point No 19

Delivery Period: The equipment should be delivered to Central University of Haryana and within a time period of 2-4 months from the date of issue of work order and complete installation, testing & commissioning within 30 days after date of arrival. If any material/component is not delivered by the date specified therein, the

University reserves the right, without liability, to cancel the order by exercising the clause of liquidated damages.

Any provisions thereof for delivery by instalment shall not be construed as obligatory unless agreed upon by both the parties. The University shall have the right to refuse deliveries made more than one week in advance of any delivery schedule appearing in the order unless arrangements for such early delivery have been confirmed with the receiving party.
